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INTERNAL RULES OF THE SOCIO-EDUCATIVE CENTRE

INTRODUCTION

These internal rules are a supplement to the regulations of an association according to the French law, LAW 1901, without modifying or altering their contents. The present rules apply unreservedly to all members who have acknowledged having a copy during registration.

The Association was created within the framework of the French government-issued ministerial circulars of 19.12.1968 and 25.10.1996, named F.S.E of the French school "BONAPARTE" of DOHA (Qatar) whose head office is housed in the establishment.

The functioning of the association is directly placed under the authority of its President within context and respect to the current rules of Bonaparte school, in DOHA (QATAR), represented by its head teacher, ex-officio member.

Article 1

The F.S.E aims to offer and organise every year for the pupils of Bonaparte school the largest number of sports and cultural activities possible. In this respect the centre takes all useful measures to surround itself with voluntary or professional participants to successfully carry out these activities.

Article 2

As soon as the school year has started, the board will prepare a presentation document of the activities offered to its members, validated by the head teacher. The F.S.E will try its hardest to satisfy the wishes of all its members but has no obligation to do so, whether it be regarding a chosen activity or the number of activities desired.

Registration and inscription forms will be delivered by electronic mail to those interested. They have to be completed and brought back during the time of inscriptions.

Article 3

According to the article 14 of the regulations of the F.S.E a contribution fee per activity is asked for each inscription. This amount was proposed by the Board of directors of the centre and voted for by the General Assembly. This inscription is considered definitive and non refundable.

Article 4

In each of the proposed, cultural or sports activities, the members make a commitment to

- Respect the internal rules of Bonaparte school
- Arrive on time to the activity(ies) chosen
- Participate regularly in the activity(ies) chosen
- Comply to the particular rules of use, of the locations made available
- Respect the equipment made available;
- Comply to the decisions made by the intervenor and the F.S.E assistant
- Comply to rules of the game;
- Respect the decisions made by the referee or the judge;
- Respect opponents and partners;
- Refuse any form of violence and cheating;
- Have self-control in all circumstances;
- Be exemplary, generous and tolerant.

In case of serious breach of the elementary rules of community life, the F.S.E, made-up of all members, and after cross-examination of the involved, can reach a decision of temporary or definitive exclusion without prejudice for the F.S.E of an appeal in compensation in case of damage to equipment.

Article 5

Within the framework of the activities exercised within the Bonaparte school, the children are covered by a third-party insurance. Before and after every activity, the child is under the responsibility of his or her parents. During sporting or cultural events held outside of the school, registrants are under the full responsibility of their parents.

For its part, the F.S.E, legal entity, its President and the committy members,

individuals and intervenors subscribe, via the school "BONAPARTE", guarantees of Civil and Criminal liability insurance, which is held by the school.

Article 6

The registrants are informed that the various intervenors of every activity can be either professionals or volunteers. The Board will work to ensure the perfect competence and morality of the intervenors.

Article 7

The present internal rules were submitted and approved by the Board of directors of the F.S.E during its session of 17/09/2014.
